MINUTES BUSINESS MEETING

The Business Meeting was convened at 7:30 am chaired by William Brien, M.D., President. Approximately 60 COA members were in attendance as was Diane Przepiorski, Executive Director.

Minutes – April 25, 2015

The minutes of the April 25, 2015 Business Meeting were approved as written.

President's Report

Dr. Brien reported on discussions that COA leadership has been having with Blue Shield Medical Directors regarding prior authorizations for total joint replacements – hip and knee. Blue Shield sought COA's input into the guidelines. In addition to providing input into the guidelines, COA urged Blue Shield to exempt those surgeons reporting outcome data to the California Joint Replacement Registry (CJRR) from the pre-authorization requirement. Blue Shield agreed and started working directly with CJRR on the exemption.

ABOS MOC Survey Results

COA members were given the results of COA's ABOS MOC survey. The survey was sent to CA Fellows and as well as Fellows in other states. The survey clearly indicated dissatisfaction with the MOC testing process – particularly the 10-year test and case presentations. Another concern was that the test was not improving patient care. In presenting the survey results, Dr. Besh felt that the COA survey results would provide valuable input to the AAOS and the ABOS as they review the MOC process.

Financial Report

Membership Committee

Dr. Brien directed members to a report on COA Membership which shows that membership in COA remains good, but was down 2016. He indicated that this is a result of orthopaedic surgeons practicing in new practice settings and sometimes feeling that membership in their professional organization was no longer important. COA needs to continue to work hard to demonstrate its relevancy to its membership.

By-Laws Amendments

Leslie Kim, M.D., Chair of the By-Laws Committee presented the members with proposed amendments to COA's By-Laws which, among other changes, established a new membership category for COA – "General Affiliate Member." The members were provided with a copy of

the By-Laws showing the proposed amendments. The By-Laws amendments were adopted unanimously.
