612 AAOS FELLOWS RESPONDED TO THE SURVEY

14 STATES REPRESENTED IN THE SURVEY RESULTS

Survey Results:

The six core areas <u>most valuable</u> in meeting the goals of demonstrating life-long learning and clinical competency were:

- 1. Continuing Medical Education Category 1 Hours 62.28%
- 2. Self-Assessment Examination Hours 14.21%
- 3. Written or Oral Exam Every 10 Years 8.46%
- 4. Querying of Colleagues 8.11%
- 5. Case Collection 5.05%
- 6. Querying of Hospital Administration –1.89%

The six core areas <u>most onerous</u> in meeting the goals of demonstrating life-long learning and clinical competency were:

- 1. Written or Oral Exam Every 10 Years 50.00%
- 2. Case Collection 30.20%
- 3. Continuing Medical Education Category 1 Hours 10.15%
- 4. Querying of Hospital Administration 4.26%
- 5. Self-Assessment Examination Hours 3.31%
- 6. Querying of Colleagues 2.08%

Only 3.61% of respondents agree that the written exam is sufficiently specialty specific. 49.59% strongly disagree or disagree with this statement.

Only 3.77% of respondents agree that the written exam is clinically relevant. 44.92% strongly disagree or disagree with this statement.



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37.33% of respondents agree or strongly agree that the oral exam is more representative of their clinical practice than the written exam. 23.69% disagree or strongly disagree with this statement.

86.53% of respondents agree or strongly agree that they would support the option of increased CME and Self Assessment requirements in lieu of the Written or Oral Pathway.
