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Trump administration releases healthcare choice and competition plan

Earlier this week, the Trump administration issued a 119-page report detailing more than 50 recommendations to promote choice and competition in the U.S. healthcare system. The report describes how various stakeholders, laws, and regulations affect the current state of competition. It concludes that healthcare spending is rising, and the administration believes certain regulations are suffocating choice and competition. Its recommendations to reverse course fall under four general areas: Healthcare Workforce and Labor Markets, Healthcare Provider Markets, Healthcare Insurance Markets, and Consumer-driven Health Care.
